



2021 CYPRUS DIGITAL MOTORSPORT CUP

National Cup Guidelines

Race Platform

1. Either a PlayStation 4 or PlayStation 5 device.
2. Gran Turismo Sport Game (Found on PS Store). Under License from Polyphony Digital.
3. Vehicle Groups allowed are Gr.4 and Gr.3.
4. All Races will be conducted under "Balance of Performance (BOP) and Tuning Prohibited settings.

Competitors

1. All competitors must have a Cyprus Automobile Association Digital Driver License for the year 2021. For this year the license free will be subsidized from the Cyprus Automobile Association.
2. All Competitors must live in Cyprus and have Cypriot Passport.
3. Minimum age is 16 for any driver to be allowed to take part at MENA Cup Finals that will be held in Jordan on the 10th – 11th of September 2021. At the end of this event the MENA Digital Motorsport Champion will be crowned.
4. Drivers younger than 16 will be allowed to take part only in the 2021 Cyprus Digital Cup.

Hardware Equipment

1. PlayStation 4 or PlayStation 5.
2. Driving Simulator Equipment including Wheelbase, Wheel and Pedals.
3. High-speed Internet.

Software Equipment

1. Latest version of Grand Turismo Sport (Found in PlayStation Store).
2. Latest version of PlayStation Software.
3. Each driver must have a valid PlayStation Network Account and a valid PlayStation Plus Subscription at the time the qualifiers start and in the finals.
4. An Active Discord Account (Optional).

National Cup

1. In the interest of supporting social distancing measures, the 2021 Cyprus Digital Cup will be done virtually. Each driver will be able to participate from a location that suits him.
2. The 1st phase of the Mena Cup will be the 2021 Cyprus Digital Cup. This phase is divided into 2 stages.
3. The 1st stage of the 2021 Cyprus Digital Cup is the National Qualifiers with the objective of selecting 12 drivers to participate in the Cyprus 2021 Digital Cup Final.





4. The 2nd stage of the 2021 Cyprus Digital Cup is The 2021 Cyprus Digital Cup Final. The objective of this single race will be to select the top 2 (of the 12 drivers) to participate in the Mena Cup Finals in Amman – Jordan.
5. In the case of inability of these drivers to travel and participate in the MENA Cup Finals, the drivers with lower ranks will be allowed to participate in accordance with their results.
6. If the number of registered drivers for the Cyprus 2021 Digital Cup is 12 or less, Cyprus Automobile Association is not obliged to Conduct National Qualifiers. All registered drivers can participate.

Mena Cup Finals

1. The 2nd phase of the Mena Cup is the MENA Cup Finals. This will be organized by JMS, it will be held in Amman / Jordan on the 10th – 11th of September 2021. It will be held in the auditorium on front of a live audience. At the end of this event the MENA Digital Motorsport Champion will be crowned.
